Tribal Parks Allies' Protocol Agreement 2022

The Operator: Recognizing that:

- 1) The łaʔuuk^{wi}iath First Nation carefully manages the haʔuukⁱ (~land, water, air, fire, names, songs, dances, regalia, etc.) and continues to protect essential ecosystems;
- 2) Our business operates within the haʔuukⁱ, benefitting from the stewardship the łaʔuuk^{wi}iath continue to assert over the lands and waters our clients come to experience;
- 3) Use of the haʔuukⁱ bears economic, social, cultural, and ecological costs – borne inequitably by the First Nation – and exacerbates the need for an effective Tribal Parks Guardians program;

We wish to become Tribal Parks Allies by meeting the following Certification Criteria. We will:

- 1) Acknowledge the haʔuukⁱ of the łaʔuuk^{wi}iath ʔawiih;
- 2) Contribute a 1% Ecosystem Service Fee to the łaʔuuk^{wi}iath Tribal Parks;
- 3) Work with łaʔuuk^{wi}iath Tribal Parks to develop a communications protocol which aligns our branding & representation of the haʔuukⁱ with łaʔuuk^{wi}iath messaging;
- 4) Work with łaʔuuk^{wi}iath Tribal Parks to support their ecological and cultural priorities;
- 5) Report territorial concerns (e.g. spills, development, dumping) to Tribal Parks Staff;
- 6) Make an effort to participate in Tribal Parks events and community workshops;
- 7) Educate ownership, staff, and guests about the history and politics of the Tribal Parks.

The łaʔuuk^{wi}iath First Nation:

In recognition of the Operator's commitment to these criteria, the Operator will be designated as an official Tribal Parks Ally. The łaʔuuk^{wi}iath First Nation will provide Allies with consultation, advice, and educational resources as they strive to implement these criteria. We will advocate for and publicize the Operator's business as a supporter of the Tribal Parks vision. The Ecosystem Service Fee will be used to support ecosystem restoration, environmental monitoring initiatives, infrastructure development, and social programs within the haʔuukⁱ. All Ecosystem Service Fee revenues generated by our Tribal Parks Allies will be accounted for separately from general łaʔuuk^{wi}iath First Nation operating revenues. We will continue to produce an Annual Report, which will be shared with Allies at our Annual Tribal Parks Gathering and publicized through our newsletter, social media, and the Tribal Parks website.
